The Son: assumed our <u>humanity</u> .
The Spirit: _ <del>dwells</del> with us.
Imagery of the Godhead: The Father <u>created</u> , then He <u>rested</u> . The Son <u>redeemed</u> , then He <u>sat with God</u> .
Father: The work of creation  Son: The work of redemption  Spirit: The work of transformation  .
The deity of the Father is <u>assumed</u> . The deity of the Son is <u>debated</u> .  The deity of the Spirit is <u>inferred</u> throughout scripture.

The Holy Spirit is <u>Divine</u> and has <u>attributes</u> that confirm this.
1. <u>Omniscience (all-knowing)</u> (1 Corinthians 2:9-11)
This is an _ <mark>incommunicable</mark> attribute of God. (cannot be _ <mark>transferred</mark> )
2. <u>Omnipotent (all-powerful)</u> (Luke 1:35)
3. <u>Omnipresence (everywhere at once)</u> (Psalm 139:7-10)
