The Doctrine of the Trinity

The Father, The Son, The Holy Spirit.

The Father: the transcendent One.

The Son: assumed our humanity.

The Spirit: dwells with us.

Imagery of the Godhead:

The Father created, then He rested.

The Son redeemed, then He sat with God.

Father: The work of creation.

Son: The work of redemption.

Spirit: The work of transformation.

The deity of the Father is assumed. The deity of the Son is debated.

The deity of the Spirit is inferred throughout scripture.

Ephesians 2:19-22

1 Kings 8:27

The Holy Spirit is Divine and has attributes that confirm this.

1. Omniscience (all-knowing) (1 Corinthians 2:9-11)

This is an incommunicable attribute of God. (cannot be transferred)

2. Omnipotent (all-powerful) (Luke 1:35)

3. Omnipresence (everywhere at once) (Psalm 139:7-10)
