2 Thessalonians 1:1-12

- 1. Perseverence, Justice, Grace, and <u>PATIENCE</u> are all tied together by Paul in 2 Thessalonians.
- 2. Paul, Silas, and Timothy all prayed that God would make the Thessalonians <u>FIT</u> for what He had called them to be.
- 3. If your life honors the name of <u>JESUS</u>, He will honor you.
- 4. Paul's primary ministry was to the **GENTILES**.
- 5. Peter's primary ministry was to the <u>JEWS</u> in Jerusalem and those scattered in the world.
- 6. Peter was never in <u>ROME</u> and yet the Catholic church considers him the first Bishop of Rome. Catholics recognized the Pope as the successor to Saint Peter.
- 7. Peter and Paul spent only <u>FIFTEEN DAYS</u> together here on earth and that time together was in Jerusalem.
- 8. Peter wrote only <u>TWO</u> Epistles or Letters and they were 1&2 Peter.
- 9. Paul wrote <u>THIRTEEN</u> Epistles or Letter including Romans, 1&2 Corinthians, Philemon, Galatians, Philippians, 1&2 Thessalonians, Ephesians, Colossians, 1&2 Timothy, and Titus.
- 10. I Peter and I Thessalonians has <u>FIVE</u> Chapters.
- 11. II Peter and II Thessalonians has <u>THREE</u> Chapters.
- 12. The themes of I Peter and I Thessalonians have many unique <u>SIMILARITIES.</u>
- 13. Both sections of Scripture talk about <u>SUFFERING</u> and perseverance and adversity and patience.
- 14. The themes of II Peter and II Thessalonians have parallels including suffering and remembering the <u>GRACE</u> of God.
- 15. II Thessalonians 1 talks about <u>THREE</u> different kinds of Faith.
- 16. <u>PERSECUTION</u> has never hurt the Church but the Church always thrives in persecution.

- 17. Persecution increase <u>FAITH</u> and brings the Body of Christ together.
- 18. In <u>ACTS</u> we learn that the first persecution of the church in Jerusalem led to the rapid expansion of the Church.
- 19. Expect a <u>THRIVING</u> Church as persecution of Christians increases in America.
- 20. Jesus said that He will come again and a <u>BETTER</u> day is coming.
- 21. Paul to the Ephesian Elders the last time he met with them said: "I am innocent of the <u>BLOOD</u> of all men for I have declared unto you the whole counsel of God.
- 22. Jesus told His disciples He was leaving and that He would go and prepare a <u>PLACE</u> for them.
- 23. Knowing that they were upset, He said: Let not your heart be <u>TROUBLED</u>. You believe in God believe also in Me. For in my Father's House are many mansions. If it were not so, I would have told you.
- 24. Paul said pray that you will be accounted <u>WORTHY</u> to be numbered with God's people in that Day to escape God's wrath.
- 25. Paul is telling the Thessalonians and us to Take a stand for <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u> while we have the opportunity and persevere for our reward is coming.
