Book of Revelation Chapter 13

Intro: The Bible was not written <u>to</u> us, it was written <u>for</u> us. The Believers relationship with Rome is critical to understanding this chapter.

John knew of Rome's corrupting influence:

- Their leader was <u>deity</u>.
- <u>Economics</u>.

13:1 The **Beast from the Sea** is for sure <u>a super human enemy/ an anti-</u> <u>Christ</u>.

Notice the obvious connections between the Dragon and the Beasts (v. 1-4; 11-15).

The beast is operating under the power of the <u>**Dragon**</u> (v. 2, 4, 5).

- 13:2 Leopard, bear and lion are similar to the vision in Daniel 7.
- 13:3 Fatal head wound may be: <u>Nero or Roman Empire</u>
- 13:4 This echoes Exodus 15:3-18.
- 13:7 The many martyrs must be read in light of 12:11.
- 13:8 All inhabitants will worship the beast except those who follow Jesus.
- 13:11 The **Beast from the land** is described in terms of what it <u>does</u>, not what it looks like.

This beast is probably _the cult of the emperor_____

Anti-Christ and the Mark of the Beast

Biblical idea of the Anti-Christ:

- 1. A general ______. (1 John 2:18, 22; 4:3; 2 John 7; Rev 13:1-2)
- 2. The world's system. (Daniel 2:24-45;7:23-27)
- 3. A human being. (2 Thessalonians 2:1-12)

13:16 Mark of the Beast

666: An allusion to <u>the creation story</u>.

- 1. Involves <u>worshipping</u> the Beast or his system.
- 2. Involves prioritizing <u>material</u> interests over eternal issues.
- 3. Involves a "mark" on the head or hand.
- 4. Involves participation in a "spirit."
