After the "set up" of, "In view of God's mercy," Paul gives two imperatives:

1. Offer your bodies as a living <u>sacrifice</u>.

This is both <u>comforting</u> and <u>troubling</u>.

_<u>Living</u> sacrifice: This will be <u>ongoing</u>. _<u>Holy</u> sacrifice _<u>Pleasing</u> sacrifice

2. Do not <u>conform</u>, but be <u>transformed</u>.

- b. The <u>worship</u> of a lie. (v.25)
- c. A depraved <u>mind</u>. (v.28)
