**LOOKING BACK:** John 4:27-38

After Jesus speaks with the woman at the well, the disciples ask Him if He'd like something to eat.

Could it be that the disciples were more concerned about sandwiches than they were about salvation?

1. Discuss what your role is as a believer. What is our job in this world after God saves us?
2. Do you feel as if you've gotten distracted in your mission as a follower of Jesus?

**DIGGING DEEPER:** "He changed my life, and He can change yours."

3. What was it about the woman that made the people stop what they were doing to come out and meet Jesus?

We tend to get caught up in using the right words with people, but in verse 39 it says, "Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in Him because of the woman's testimony, 'He told me everything I ever did.'" They believed in Jesus because of the woman's story.

**TAKING IT HOME:** Does it matter what we do in this world if we don't make heaven?

Jeremiah 2:13, "My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken me, the spring of living water, and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water."

4. When was the last time you woke up and wished for people to see God through your life? What are some practical ways in which you can step into your role as a believer?
