GETTING TO KNOW YOU:

1. Share one of your first or favorite memories of being in a church building.

RECAP:

Sometimes we are so accustomed to using a word (like church, devotion, fellowship) in Christian circles that we lose the strength of their meaning. On Sunday, Dale began a series of teachings on THE CHURCH today. He taught from the second chapter of Acts. Acts is a history book. It chronicles the history of the church from its birth to the vast and explosive growth it witnessed spreading the Good News about Jesus. We began to answer: What is CHURCH? What does it look like to be a part of THE CHURCH? What does the Bible have to say about who the church is and what the church does? And, does that match our beliefs and actions?

Verse: Acts 1:1-5, 8; Acts 2:1-4, 38-47

Acts 2:42 says that the church "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer." That means they made a strong adherence, persistence and commitment to these things. It was a "no matter what" mindset in their lives.

4. Which of these areas of church life do you tend to gravitate toward? Which do you need to grow in? Explain.
