1. Masoretic Text	
The oldest complete manuscript of the Hebrew Bible is the <u>Leningr</u>	ad Codex
Leviticus 11:42: the third letter of the word "belly" is the center of the	Torah .

2. <u>Septuagint</u>	
Also known by the Greek Roman numeral <u>LXX</u> Genesis 4:8	
3. <u>Dead Sea Scrolls</u>
