2 Themes from Proverbs:

≅ <u>The Heart</u>

Proverbs draws a cause and effect relationship between the <u>condition</u> of the heart and how we <u>live life</u>.

Proverbs 27:19, "As water reflects the face, so one's life reflects the heart." Proverbs 4:23, "Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life." Mathew 12:34, "For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks." Proverbs 20:5, "The purposes of a man's heart are deep waters, but those who have understanding draw them out."

Wisdom dictates that the only <u>"normal</u>" we compare against is <u>Jesus</u>.

Wisdom begins with a correct <u>view of God</u>. Therefore, Proverbs draws a cause and effect relationship between our <u>concept</u> of God and how we <u>live life</u>.
