

*Who Do You Say I Am? – Mark 4:35 - 5:20*

Mark 3:6

6 Then the Pharisees went out and began to plot with the Herodians how they might kill Jesus.

Read Mark 4:35-41

It's easy to (forget) Jesus' words in the middle of a (storm)

In his humanity Jesus is (weary and empty) and needs (rest) from the crowd and (quiet) for His soul

The storm is so (violent) that even (experienced) fisherman are (afraid) for their lives

(Fear) wipes out (faith)

When the Word of Jesus is left lying (undeveloped) and (unapplied) to any situation that we're going through, inevitably fear comes

1 Corinthians 10:13

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

You are not (unique) in your temptation

God does not (abandon) you while you are being tempted

God (sets limits) on every temptation

He always provides an (exit strategy)

Sometimes Jesus delivers us (from) the storm and sometimes He delivers us (in) the storm

Read Mark 5:1-20

1st characteristic of demonization is some manifestation of (physical control) that the demon has over the body of the person

The 2<sup>nd</sup> characteristic is (supernatural knowledge)

The 3<sup>rd</sup> characteristic is a person's (desire) to be (free)

Matthew 9:35-38

35 Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.

36 When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

37 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few.

38 Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.
