## **DIGGING DEEPER:**

Verse: 1 Samuel 14:1-23

Saul was paralyzed by fear. The people were hiding in caves. Jonathan bravely went to battle. On Sunday, Sean shared that the enemy will often draw a "chicken line" and then dare us to cross it. He said, "You must leave your *comfort zone* and go through the *battle zone* to enter your *blessing zone*."

Courage speaks to those who don't have it yet. When the enemy ran, all the people came out of their caves and pursued them. Jonathan's courage started a movement.
