The audience was _ God-fearing Jews
- Evangelism as a PROCESS is <u>Acts 17</u> .
The audience was _ <mark>Epicureans</mark> and _ <mark>Stoics</mark>
The moment the audience changes, the <u>approach</u> must also change.
"We want to hear you again on this subject." (Acts 17:32)
- Evangelism driven by <u>explanation</u> .
The old and new <u>apologetics</u> .
"Old" is answering questions through <u>evidence</u> .
"New" is addressing questions through <u>experience</u> .
<u>Truth</u> addresses the <u>intellectual</u> barriers.
Explanation addresses the experiential barriers.
The <u>grace</u> and <u>truth</u> tension.
