He uses the imagery of the <u>tabernacle</u> and <u>temple</u> to help his readers understand the <u>indwelling</u> of the Holy Spirit.

Now, the presence of God is with <u>ME</u> !

- The View from John (9 Occurrences)

1. John 1:32-34

The Holy Spirit <u>reveals</u> to us that <u>Jesus</u> is <u>God</u>.

2. John 3:1-8

The Holy Spirit is the source of new <u>life</u>. (Spiritual <u>rebirth</u>)

3. John 3:34

The Holy Spirit speaks <u>to</u> us and <u>through</u> us.

4. John 4:23-24

The Holy Spirit directs us to true <u>worship</u> of God. <u>Worship</u> of God is not about a holy <u>place</u> but a holy <u>Person</u> .
5. John 7:37-39
The Holy Spirit is a constant and consistent source of <u>life</u> and <u>refreshment</u>
6. John 14:15-17; 25-26
The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of <u>truth</u> .
The Holy Spirit relates to us in two ways: <u>with</u> us and <u>in</u> us.
The ministry of the Holy Spirit is <u>instruction</u> . (v. 25-26)
7. John 15:26-27
The Holy Spirit wants to elevate <u>Jesus</u> .
The Holy Spirit exists to <u>reveal</u> and <u>prove</u> who Jesus is.
8. John 16:5-11
The Holy Spirit is God's <u>presence</u> with us.
The Holy Spirit <u>convicts</u> of sin so we feel <u>far</u> from God.
We don't need to <u>know</u> what we <u>will</u> need to know.
9. John 20:21-22
The Holy Spirit now <u>sends</u> us to continue His <u>work</u> .
