This begins the process of God's judgments poured out upon the earth to <u>redeem</u>		
"The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, ⁷ maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin" Exodus 34:6, 7		
It is likely that the Seals covers the same span of time covered by the Trumpets and Bowls (Compare 6:12-14 to 11:15, 18 and 16:17, 20).		
These judgments are what Jesus characterized by the <u>present age</u> (Mark 13:7-8)		
1 First Seal – White Horse is <u>CONQUEST</u> .		
Second Seal – Red Horse is <u>BLOODSHED</u> .		
6:5 Third Seal – Black Horse is FAMINE .		
6:7 Fourth Seal – Pale Horse is		
Equivalent images for us may be <u>economic collapse, drought, war, terrorism, cancer</u> .		
6:9 Fifth Seal – The <u>MARTYRS</u> .		
The altar is in <u>heaven</u> . They cry out for <u>justice</u> , not in complaint. They have white robes for righteousness.		
6:12 Sixth Seal - GREAT EARTHQUAKE .		
Judgment serves a <u>redemptive</u> purpose, not only to invite <u>repentance</u> from the disobedient (9:20-21) but to vindicate the righteous <u>oppressed</u> (6:10).
