Five Reasons to Give Thanks

- Psalm 16
1. Inheritance: A guaranteed <u>outcome</u>
2. Portion: Planned <u>process</u> .
3. Cup: Securing <u>power</u> .
 Col. 1:17 – "He is before all things, and in him all things hold together" (all things consist) Hebrews 1:3 – "Sustaining all things by his powerful word" John 1:3 – "Through him all things were made"
4. Lot: Supporting <u>Savior</u> . "made my lot secure"
5. Power of <u>thanklessness</u> . Romans 1:21-32
The more materialistic a person (or culture) becomes, the more shallow their view of life becomes.
An <u>entitled</u> culture is a <u>self-deceived</u> culture.
Lost perspective of <u>God</u> . Lost perspective of <u>creation</u> . Lost perspective of <u>ourselves</u> . (Romans 1:18-21)
A simple "thank you" means: I am not <mark>self-sufficient</mark> A simple "thank you" places _ <mark>value</mark> and _ <u>worth_</u> on others.
