Justification <u>Sanctification</u> Glorification
<u>Sanctification</u> means, "The state of proper <u>functioning</u> ."
The Greek word is <u>hagios</u> which we translate - <u>HOLY</u> .
"the gracious and continuous operation of the Holy Spirit by which He delivers the justified sinner from the pollution of sin, renews his nature in the image of God, and enables him to perform good works."
Justification is an act Sanctification is aprocess
Justification is a <u>moment</u> in time <u>transaction</u> . Sanctification is a
<u>lifelong journey</u>
In Justification, God <u>declares</u> you to be a <u>righteous</u> person.
In Sanctification, God <u>develops</u> you into a <u>righteous</u> person.
1. We are to be <u>dead</u> to the <u>power</u> of sin.
Paul is not saying that it is <u>impossible</u> to sin as a believer – but that it is <u>morally incongruous</u> to sin.
True freedom is not the ability to do as wewant, but the ability to do as weought!
Therefore, my action of not sinning comes NOT from the fear of what God will do TO me My life of obedience is in response to what God has done. FOR me

2. You belong to the <u>power</u> you choose to <u>obey</u> .
2 Powers: - Sin - Obedience
When you choose the power of <u>sin</u> - you are a slave to sin and <u>death</u> is the paycheck.
When you choose the power of <u>obedience</u> - you become a slave to obedience and the <u>paycheck</u> is righteousness.
You cannot be <u>employed</u> by both <u>simultaneously</u> .
3. We must live to match our <u>practice</u> with our <u>position</u> .
We offer every <u>aspect</u> of our lives as <u>instruments</u> of righteousness.
The parts of our body can be used for <u>ruin</u> or <u>righteousness</u> .
