

KING AHAB 7th KING

1 Kings 16:29-30 (NASB) Now Ahab the son of Omri became king over Israel in the thirty-eighth year of Asa king of Judah, and Ahab the son of Omri reigned over Israel in Samaria twenty-two years.

KING AHAB 7th KING

1 Kings 16:29-30 (NASB)
30 Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD more than all who were before him.

THE CRIMES

2 Kings 17:1-2 (NASB) In the twelfth year of Ahaz king of Judah, Hoshea the son of Elah became king over Israel in Samaria, and reigned nine years.

THE CRIMES

2 Kings 17:1-2 (NASB)
He did evil in the sight of the LORD, only not as the kings of Israel who were before him.

2 Kings 17:3-4 (NASB) Shalmaneser king of Assyria came up against him, and Hoshea became his servant and paid him tribute.

- 2 Kings 17:5-6 (NASB)
- 6 In the ninth year of Hoshea, the king of Assyria captured Samaria and carried Israel away into exile to Assyria, and settled them in Halah and Habor, on the river of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes.

2 Kings 17:24-29 (NASB)

The king of Assyria brought men from Babylon and from Cuthah and from Avva and from Hamath and Sepharvaim, and settled them in the cities of Samaria in place of the sons of Israel. So they possessed Samaria and lived in its cities.

2 Kings 17:24-29 (NASB) 25 At the beginning of their living there, they did not fear the LORD; therefore the LORD sent lions among them which killed some of them.

2 Kings 17:24-29 (NASB)

26 So they spoke to the king of Assyria, saying, "The nations whom you have carried away into exile in the cities of Samaria do not know the custom of the god of the land; so he has sent lions among them, and behold, they kill them because they do not know the custom of the god of the land."

27 Then the king of Assyria commanded, saying, "Take there one of the priests whom you carried away into exile and let him go and live there; and let him teach them the custom of the god of the land."

2 Kings 17:24-29 (NASB) 28 So one of the priests whom they had carried away into exile from Samaria came and lived at Bethel, and taught them how they should fear the LORD.

29 But every nation still made gods of its own and put them in the houses of the high places which the people of Samaria had made, every nation in their cities in which they lived.
