Mark 9:2-6 “Six days later Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. As the men watched, Jesus’ appearance was transformed, and his clothes became dazzling white, far whiter than any earthly bleach could ever make them. Then Elijah and Moses appeared and began talking with Jesus. Peter exclaimed, ‘Rabbi, it’s wonderful for us to be here! Let’s make three shelters as memorials—one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.’ He said this because he didn’t really know what else to say, for they were all terrified.”

Mark 5:37 “Then Jesus stopped the crowd and wouldn’t let anyone go with him except Peter, James, and John (the brother of James).”

Mark 1:17 “Jesus called out to them, ‘Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!’ ”

What Does He Want To _____ Me? “...and his clothes became dazzling white, far whiter than any earthly bleach could ever make them. Then Elijah and Moses appeared and began talking with Jesus.” (vv.3-4)

Mark 9:7-8 “Then a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, ‘This is my dearly loved Son. Listen to him.’ Suddenly, when they looked around, Moses and Elijah were gone, and they saw only Jesus with them.”

Mark 9:9 “As they went back down the mountain, he told them not to tell anyone what they had seen until the Son of Man had risen from the dead.”

2 Peter 1:16-18 “For we were not making up clever stories when we told you about the powerful coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. We saw his majestic splendor with our own eyes when he received honor and glory from God the Father. The voice from the majestic glory of God said to him, ‘This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy.’ We ourselves heard that voice from heaven when we were with him on the holy mountain.”
