Great Is The Lord

Psalm 96:1-9 “Oh sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth! 2 Sing to the Lord, bless his name; tell of his salvation from day to day. 3 Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples! 4 For great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; he is to be feared above all gods. 5 For all the gods of the peoples are worthless idols, but the Lord made the heavens. 6 Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and beauty are in his sanctuary. 7 Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the peoples, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength! 8 Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an offering, and come into his courts! 9 Worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness; tremble before him, all the earth.”

Worship Is _____ “Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!” (v.3)

Declare - say something in a solemn and emphatic manner; to formally announce.”

- **His glory** - involves all the reasons for admiring and praising Him
- **His marvelous works** - great things He has done

Worship Is _____ “Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the peoples, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength!” (v.7)

Psalm 29:2 “Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness.”
