

## The Praying Church

### Let Us Pray

**Acts 1:12-14** “Then the apostles returned to Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives, a distance of half a mile. When they arrived, they went to the upstairs room of the house where they were staying. Here are the names of those who were present: Peter, John, James, Andrew, Philip, Thomas, Bartholomew, Matthew, James (son of Alphaeus), Simon (the zealot), and Judas (son of James). They all met together and were constantly united in prayer, along with Mary the mother of Jesus, several other women, and the brothers of Jesus.”

**Acts 1:6** “So when the apostles were with Jesus, they kept asking him, ‘Lord, has the time come for you to free Israel and restore our kingdom?’ ”

**Acts 1:7** “He replied, ‘The Father alone has the authority to set those dates and times, and they are not for you to know.’ ”

**Acts 1:8** “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

**Committed to** \_\_\_\_\_ “They all met together...”  
(v.14a)

**Acts 2:46** “They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord’s Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity...”

**Committed to** \_\_\_\_\_ “They all met together and were constantly *united* in prayer...” (v.14)

**Philippians 1:27** “Above all, you must live as citizens of heaven, conducting yourselves in a manner worthy of the Good News about Christ. Then, whether I come and see you again or

only hear about you, I will know that you are standing together with one spirit and one purpose, fighting together for the faith, which is the Good News.”

**Committed to** \_\_\_\_\_ “They all met together and were constantly *united in prayer*, along with Mary the mother of Jesus, several other women, and the brothers of Jesus.” (V.14)

**Colossians 4:2** “Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart.”
