Definition:

Common Sense - "Sound and prudent judgment based on a simple perception of the situation or facts.

Common Sense - the term originated in the works of Aristotle (De Anima, Book II)

- The book was about how the animal mind converts raw sense perceptions from the five senses into perceptions of real things moving and changing

Common Sense - a book published in 1776 by Thomas Paine. It challenged the authority of the British Government and the Royal Monarchy.
