3. The Invitation (Kingdom at Hand)

- Read: Mark 1:15

Questions:

1. What does it mean that “the kingdom of God is at hand”?
 2. What does stepping into God’s kingdom look like in everyday life?
 3. What might keep someone from accepting this invitation?

- Read: Luke 15:11–24 (Prodigal Son)

Questions:

1. How is repentance more than just turning away from sin?
2. Why is repentance described as a gift rather than a burden?
3. What emotions did the prodigal son experience when he returned?
4. How can repentance lead to joy in your life?

5. Responding to the Mission

Questions:

1. What does it look like for you to “repent and believe the Gospel” today?
2. Where in your life do you need to move from death to life?
3. How can you share the message of “rescue” with others this week?
