Jesus died our death so that we could share his life.



Isaiah 53:10,12

"Yet it was the Lord's will to crush him and cause him to suffer, and though the Lord makes his life an offering for sin...

...Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors"

Jesus was the perfect sacrifice

- "For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins." (Hebrews 10:4)
- "How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!" (Hebrews 9:14)

Leviticus 17:11

"For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul"

Jesus poured out His life for us when he poured out His blood for us.

How did Jesus pour out His blood?

- They lacerated His back.
- Placed a crown of large, nail-like thorns into His head.
- Pierced His hands with nails.
- Pierced His feet with nails.
- Pierced His side with a spear.

Salvation was not free, but it is now free because of Jesus Blood!

The Blood

- Purchased (Acts 20:28)
- Justified (Romans 5:9)
- Redemption (Ephesians 1:7)
- Reconciled (Colossians 1:20)
- Cleansed and forgiven (Hebrews 9:25)
- Precious (1 Peter 1:19)
- Removes our guilt and shame (Revelation 1:7)

Revelation 12:11

"And they <u>overcame</u> him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death."

- Bios: Your physical being (body).
- <u>Psuche</u>: Your mind, will, emotions. Your present and finite life.
- **Zoe**: the uncreated, eternal life of God, the divine life uniquely possessed by God.

- "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life [ZOE], and have it to the full." (John 10:10)
 - "to the full" Abundantly, more, greater, excessive, abundant, exceedingly, all-around, excess, more than, beyond what is anticipated, more than enough!
- "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life [PSUCHE] for the sheep..." (John 10:11)

"If anyone desires to come after Me [to share in the ZOE life], let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life [PSUCHE] will lose it [ZOE], but whoever loses his life [PSUCHE] will find it [ZOE]." (Matthew 16:24-25)

"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives [ZOE] in me; and the life [ZOE] which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me." (Galatians 2:20-21)
