- Jesus **died our death**, so we could **share His life**.
- Jesus was **made a curse**, so we could **receive His blessing**.
- Jesus **took our punishment**, so we could **have forgiveness**.
- Jesus **endured our poverty**, so we might **share in His abundance**.
- Jesus **bore our shame**, so we might **share His glory**.



Exchange #9

Our old man died in Jesus so
the new man lives in us



2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore if anyone is in Christ, this person is a new creation; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

1 Corinthians 15:47-48 (NLT)

Adam, the first man, was made from the dust of the earth, while Christ, the second man, came from heaven. Earthly people are like the earthly man, and heavenly people are like the heavenly

- Earthly People – Sinful nature inherited from Adam and Eve
- Heavenly People – New creation in Christ

We are born Rebels

- “Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child.” – Prov. 22:15

The root = our rebellion

Only 1 Remedy for a Rebel



Romans 6:6-7

For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.

Romans 6:11 (The Message)

From now on, think of it this way: Sin speaks a dead language that means nothing to you; God speaks your mother tongue, and you hang on every word. You are dead to sin and alive to God. That's what Jesus did.

1. Put Off the Old Man

- “You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to **put off your old self**, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires.” - Ephesians 4:22
- Get accountability
- Turn temptation into praise

2. Make No Provision for the Old Man

- Romans 13:14 – But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and **make no provision for the flesh**, to fulfill its lust.
- Provision: The act of making preparations for a possible or future event or situation

3. Put On The New Man

- Ephesians 4:22-24 - You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to **put on the new self, created to be like God** in true righteousness and holiness.
- Romans 13:14 - But **put on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

3. Put On The New Man

- Bible Study
- Discipleship
- “And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. **Fix your thoughts** on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. **Think about things** that are excellent and worthy of praise. **Keep putting into practice** all you learned and received from me—everything you heard from me and saw me doing. Then the God of peace will be with you.” - Philippians 4:8-9

Colossians 3:12 – 14

- Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
