### **Big Stick Diplomacy**

Theodore Roosevelt

"Speak softly and carry a big stick" diplomacy

 The idea is negotiating peacefully, or to avoid war and allow your adversary to save face

### **Troubling Statistics**

#### Suicide 10-24 year olds, rose 61% from 2007 to 2018

- Second cause of death for that age group
- Rose 51% during 2020 Covid isolation exacerbated underlying issues
- 27% of US Families have an estranged adult child
  - 40% of US families experience temporary estrangement
- **20+ million Americans struggle with substance abuse**
- During 2020 30% increase in drug overdose

**12.7% of all 18 and above take anti-depressants** – 10% of age 10+

During 2020 rose to 22% of adult Americans
 Those taking Anti-Anxiety prescriptions rose 31% during 2020

### Paul's Life Summary

- A Pharisee among Pharisees
- Persecuted & Executed Christians
- Personally, recounts approving of Stephen's Stoning
   Never know who is going to be the next Saul to Paul
- Conversion road to Damascus
- Ananias Go! Chosen instrument I will show him how much he must suffer for my name!
- Not accepted in Jerusalem Apostles
- 14 years as a tent maker learning

### Continued

- Apostles in Jerusalem agree he should reach the gentiles
- Rejected by Jews everywhere he went
- Misunderstood, teaching criticized, personally made fun of
- Passionately fought against the tendency of the church to go back to traditions and "works"
- Preached in 49 cities, regions and countries
- Suffered Countless physical issues

### Paul's Physical Battles

<sup>24</sup> Five times I received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. <sup>25</sup> Three times I was beaten with rods,pelted with stones, - three times I was shipwrecked, night and a day in the open sea, <sup>-</sup> danger from: - rivers, bandits, - fellow Jews, - Gentiles; - city, - country, - sea; false believers. <sup>27</sup>I - gone without sleep- hunger - thirst - without food; - cold - naked. <sup>28</sup> - pressure of my concern for all the churches.

- - - 32 In Damascus - lowered in a basket from a window. 2 Cor. 11:24-32

### There's More !!

- Heard from the Lord must testify in Rome to Ceasar's house & knew he would die to do it
- Imprisoned under house arrest in Rome

   Wrote letters 14/27 books of NT
- Died estimated age of between 61 and 68
  - Roman execution, presumed beheaded by sword

### What Was He like?

- Full of Gratitude Rom 16 thanks 28 people
- Compassion for others took up offerings on behalf of others
- Servant Heart worked so as not to be a burden
- Transparent of his struggles So & So
  - Deserted me, abandoned me, did me much harm, left me,
- Resilient you think!
- Passionate in the defense of the Gospel to Gentiles

### What Was He Like – Cont'd

- Encouraged everyone to seek and move in the power of the gifts of the Holy Spirit
- Moved in power, miracles, healing, raising the dead
- Man of prayer

### Who, Where, How, What?

2 Cor. 10:4-5 - The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. <sup>5</sup> We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

<sup>8</sup> Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.
1 Pet. 5:8 NIV

 Looking for - Greek, ζητέω (zēteō) - to seek, look for, to search after, to be on the watch for, to pursue, to endeavor to obtain,

• He is actively looking for weakness, to attack

 Devour καταπίνω (katapinō) – destroy, annihilate, engulf, submerge

### C. S. Lewis Screwtape Letters

- Teach them (Christians) to estimate the value of each prayer by their success in producing the desired feeling; and never let them suspect how much success or failure of that kind depends on whether they are well or ill, fresh or tired, at the moment.
- All extremes, except extreme devotion to the Enemy [God], are to be encouraged.

 Transformed Greek μεταμορφόω (metamorphoō) – change external form, transfigure; to undergo a spiritual transformation

How To Prepare Yourself For Prayer

### 1. How to Prepare For Prayer

Phil 4:6-9 **Do not be anxious about anything**, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with **thanksgiving**, present your requests to God. <sup>7</sup> And the **peace** of God, which **transcends all understanding**, will **guard your hearts and your minds** in Christ Jesus.

<sup>8</sup> Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. <sup>9</sup>---. And the God of peace will be with you.

### 2. Understanding our Standing

- Heb 4:16 Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
  - <u>Confidence</u> Greek παρρησία (parrēsia) boldness of speech, freedom to speak boldly, authority, confidence, unambiguously
  - <u>Receive</u> λαμβάνω (lambanō) -take in the hand, to seize upon, to make a rightful or successful assumption n of

### Balance - Caution

#### 2 Peter 2:10b-12 NLT

 Bold and arrogant, they are not afraid to heap abuse on celestial beings; <sup>11</sup> yet even angels, although they are stronger and more powerful, do not heap abuse on such beings when bringing judgment on them from the Lord. <sup>12</sup> But these people blaspheme in matters they do not understand.
