## **Characteristics of Winners**

## 1. Winners Stand Against the Odds

#### • David's friend JB

- "These are the names of David's mighty warriors: Josheb-Basshebeth (JB) a Tahkemonite, was chief of the Three; he raised his spear against eight hundred men, whom he killed in one encounter." – 2 Samuel 23:8
- JB had a <u>fire in his heart!</u>
- "If you have men who will only come if they know there is a good road, I don't want them. I want men who will come if there is no road at all." – David Livingstone

### 1. Winners Stand Against the Odds

## Eli and Sham (2 Samuel 23:9-12)

<sup>9</sup>Next to him was **Eleazar {Eli}** son of Dodai the Ahohite. As one of the three mighty warriors, he was with David when they taunted the Philistines gathered at Pas Dammim for battle. Then the Israelites retreated, <sup>10</sup> but Eleazar stood his ground and struck down the Philistines till his hand grew tired and froze to the sword. The Lord brought about a great victory that day. The troops returned to Eleazar, but only to strip the dead.

## Eli and Sham (2 Samuel 23:9-12)

<sup>11</sup>Next to him was **Shammah {Sham}** son of Agee the Hararite. When the Philistines banded together at a place where there was a field full of lentils, Israel's troops fled from them. <sup>12</sup> But Shammah {Sham} took his stand in the middle of the field. He defended it and struck the Philistines down, and the Lord brought about a great victory.

<sup>6</sup> Jonathan said to his young armor-bearer, "Come, let's go over to the outpost of those uncircumcised men. Perhaps the Lord will act in our behalf. Nothing can hinder the Lord from saving, whether by many or by few."

<sup>7</sup> "Do all that you have in mind," his armor-bearer said. "Go ahead; I am with you heart and soul."

<sup>14</sup> In that first attack Jonathan and his armor-bearer killed some twenty men in an area of about half an acre.

<sup>15</sup> Then panic struck the whole army—those in the camp and field, and those in the outposts and raiding parties—and the ground shook. It was a panic sent by God.
