Core Scripture

Hebrews 9:27 — 'It is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment.'

Key Scriptures

Acts 17:30–31 • John 5:22 • Luke 12:2 • 1 Corinthians 4:5

Teaching Breakdown

Judgment is certain and unavoidable. Scripture teaches that every person will stand before God. The same Jesus who offers salvation today has been appointed by the Father as the Judge of all humanity.

Key Points

1. Judgment is certain.
2. Jesus is the appointed Judge.
3. Eternal judgment means God's verdict is final and irreversible.
4. Judgment reveals not only actions but motives of the heart.
