Hebrews 11:1 - “Now faith is the substance of things hoped for the evidence of things not seen.”

- A. Faith is Substance

I. Faith must be present tense:

1 Peter 2:24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose [a]stripes you were healed.

Question: Does this passage promise you healing?

- In Christ healing belongs to you.

Mark 6:5

Some Facts about unbelief:

- 1. It will keep you limited
- 2. It will keep you away from the promises of God
- 3. it will put a lid on your faith
