From the Pastor's Desk

Second, we adopted a corrected budget for 2026. This action was necessary because after the adoption of the budget back in November, we discovered some errors in the budget we presented. Therefore, we needed to adopt a corrected version. If you would like a copy of the corrected budget, you may request one from the church office.

Third, Ed Brazelton from our executive pastor search committee, announced that the committee is ready to recommend a candidate for our open position. In working with the candidate's schedule and our church schedule, we have identified Sunday, March 29, as the day he will visit our church in view of a call. Please be in prayer for this individual and his family as they prepare to visit with us that day. Pray also for our committee as they work out the details of that weekend. More information will be provided, including the name of the candidate, as we get closer to March 29.

As always, I encourage you to read thoroughly the information provided in this newsletter so that you will be informed and ready to serve in the opportunities available in the days ahead. As we prepare to gather for worship this Sunday, I encourage you to read Daniel chapters 10-12 before you arrive. 
