David's oldest brother Eliab listened as he spoke to the men, and *he became angry with him*. "Why did you come down here?" he asked.

"Who did you leave those few sheep with in the wilderness? I know your arrogance and **your evil heart**—you came down to see the battle!"




1 Samuel 17:31-32 (CSB)
