

TAKING DOMINION THROUGH PRAISE

Luke 19:37-40 TPT

As soon as he got to the bottom of the Mount of Olives, the crowd of his followers shouted with a loud outburst of ecstatic joy over all the mighty wonders of power they had witnessed. [38] They shouted over and over, "Highest praises to God for the one who comes as King in the name of the Lord! Heaven's peace and glory from the highest realm now comes to us!" [39] Some Jewish religious leaders who stood off from the procession said to Jesus, "Teacher, order your followers at once to stop saying these things!" [40] Jesus responded, "Listen to me. If my followers were silenced, the very stones would break forth with praises!"

PRAISE IS NOT OPTIONAL IT IS A NECESSITY TO HAVE A WINNING LIFESTYLE

- MAKE EVERYDAY A WINNING DAY BY PRAISING THE ALMIGHTY GOD

I will praise the name of God with a song; I WILL MAGNIFY HIM WITH THANKSGIVINGS

WE ARE THINKING ABOUT THE WRONG THINGS. WHEN WE THINK WRONG, WE COMPLAIN,
WHEN WE THINK RIGHT WE PRAISE GOD

Colossians 3:2 TLB

Let heaven FILL YOUR THOUGHTS; don't spend your time worrying about things down here.

WE TAKE DOMINION BY PRAISING GOD. PRAISE MAKES US THINK ABOUT THE GOODNESS OF

OUR GOD AND FOCUS ON HIM. NOT OUR CHALLENGES. PRAISING BRINGS THE MANIFEST PRESENCE OF GOD

LET'S MAKE A DECISION TO LET PRAISES FILL OUR HOMES. NO MORE MAJORING ON THE FAILTS BUT PRAISING GOD FOR AT LEAST ONE GOOD THING OUR FAMILY MEMBERS DO.

- PRAISE BRINGS THE MANIFEST PRESENCE OF GOD ON THE SCENE

Psalm 22:3,30-31 NLT

Yet you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel. [30] Our children will also serve him. Future generations will hear about the wonders of the Lord. [31] His righteous acts will be told to those not yet born. They will hear about everything he has done.

- PRAISE IS A STRIFE STOPPER & A JOY IGNITOR.

POWER POINT - WE WANT TO DEVELOP A CONSCIOUSNESS OF THE GREAT THINGS GOD HAS DONE FOR US THROUGH JESUS.

Psalm 100:1-4 NLT

SHOUT WITH JOY TO THE LORD, ALL THE EARTH! [2] WORSHIP THE LORD WITH GLADNESS. COME BEFORE HIM, SINGING WITH JOY. [3] ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE LORD IS GOD! He made US, and WE ARE HIS. We are HIS PEOPLE, the SHEEP of HIS PASTURE. [4] Enter his gates with THANKSGIVING; go into his courts with PRAISE. GIVE THANKS to HIM and PRAISE HIS NAME.

Psalm 100:5 NLT

For the LORD IS GOOD. His UNFAILING LOVE CONTINUES FOREVER, and his FAITHFULNESS CONTINUES TO EACH GENERATION.

- PRAISE IS A SATANIC STOPPER- STOP THE WORKS OF THE DEVIL

THE DEVIL HATES FOR US TO PRAISE GOD, HE WANTS US TO PRAISE HIM. HE WANTED TO EXHALT HIMSELF ABOVE GOD. RESIST THE TEMPTATION TO GRIPE & COMPLAIN WHICH IS SATANIC PRAISE BUT BEGIN TO PRAISE AND THANK GOD FOR HIS GOODNESS.

Psalm 8:2 TPT

You have built a stronghold by the songs of children. Strength rises up with the chorus of infants. This kind of praise has power to shut Satan's mouth. Childlike worship will silence the madness of those who oppose you.

- KEEP THE DOOR CLOSED TO THE DEVIL BY PRAISING GOD

Acts 16:24-34 KJV

Who, having received such a charge, thrust them into the inner prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks. [25] And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the

prisoners heard them. [26] And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed. [27] And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled. [28] But Paul cried with a loud voice, saying, Do thyself no harm: for we are all here. [29] Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas, [30] And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? [31] And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. [32] And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house. [33] And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway. [34] And when he had brought them into his house, he set meat before them, and rejoiced, believing in God with all his house.
