Check-in

Scripture

Read Phillipians 2:1-4

Key Points From Message

Unity is when people who are not the same come together around something that defines them more than that which makes them different.

- 1. Allow Christ to characterize your view of the church
- 2. Combat selfish ambition with service
- 3. Find your significance in Christ affection and not your action

Other scripture referenced: Ephesians 2:3-5

Discover

- 1. What stands out to you in this passage of Scripture?
- 2. In verse 1 Paul starts with "If then..." What is the "if then" referring to?
- 3. In verse 2 we are instructed to be "united in spirit, intent on one purpose." What is the one purpose?
- 4. Whose interests are we supposed to place the most value on?

Deepen


- 1. What challenged you about this week's message?
- 2. Have you ever sat down and tried to view a situation through someone else's "lens?" What is a situation right now where it would be beneficial to try viewing it from someone else's perspective?
- 3. Are you comfortable with being uncomfortable for the sake of others?
- 4. What is one of the areas of your life that you tend to compare against others? How do you turn this into a way to serve others?
- 5. Do you find your significance through what you are doing for God or in God himself? If you don't find it through God, how can you change this?

Discipleship Group Framework

D-group discussions in smaller gender-specific groups help to reveal our blind spots to sin. If this week is a D-group week, the discussions should be focused on confession of sins, providing accountability, and encouraging each other to live in the gospel. This time allows us to better evaluate our relationships, emotions, and circumstances.

Action Step

In order to grow as Christians we must be unified with other Christians. We all have barriers to unity with our brothers and sisters in the church. Based on the discussion today evaluate where the gospel needs to be applied in your life to have a Christ-centered view. Discuss this area with your community group. Discuss where you need to combat selfish ambition with service so they can hold you accountable.
