Discussion Questions

1. Which Church Movements and/or church “fads” have you been a part of, and which ones have you been apart from? What have you learned from these movements or “fads”?
2. How much emphasis has there been on the Holy Spirit in your church background? What have you been taught? What do you believe?
3. How have you personally experienced the work of the Holy Spirit in your life?
4. Read Ephesians 5:15-19 and then point out the similarities between being drunk and being Spirit-filled. Then also point out the differences between the two. Why do you think the Apostle Paul used being “drunk with wine” as a comparison to being “filled with the Spirit”?
5. Although some church movements have confused being “Spirit filled” with being “baptized by the Spirit”, how are they different? (For help, compare 1 Cor. 12:13 with Eph. 5:18,19.) Why is knowing that they are different important?
6. How does one “quench the Holy Spirit” (1 Thess. 5:19) and what are the consequences of doing so? (Hint: see Gal. 5:16-25.)
7. How is one “filled with the Holy Spirit”? (Hint: recall the acronym D.A.Y.)
