Discussion Questions

1. Are you in love? How do you know?
2. Is someone in love with you? How do you know?
3. Love gives. What are some of the most common ways people show love by giving? In what ways do you like to show your love through giving? What circumstances make it especially hard to love by giving? What does God's example teach us about giving love when it is really hard?
4. Love is selfless. Whom is it easy to love selflessly? Whom is it really hard to love selflessly? Share an example of selfish love? How can you avoid that type of love?
5. Love sacrifices. What is one of the biggest sacrifices that someone (other than God) has made for you? How did that make you feel? What is one of the biggest sacrifices YOU have made for someone? How did that make you feel?
6. What are some things in the story of Abraham “sacrificing” Isaac that you really like? What are some things in the story that you really don't like? (Refer to Gen. 22:1–19 as needed.)
7. Love isn't just a feeling, and sometimes it actually doesn't feel good at all. Just ask your children! With that in mind, how would you answer someone who doubts God's love for them because of what they are feeling or experiencing in life right now? What Scriptures would you share?
8. How can you increase your love for others? For God?
