5. How do you feel when you do something good for others, and yet remain anonymous to those whom you have blessed?
6. Read Mk. 12:41–44. This widow worshiped God by giving her all. What does “all out” worship look like in your life? What should “all out” worship of God look like in our lives?
7. What is the one thing that strikes you the most about the people of Jesus’s final days?
