Discussion Questions

1. If you could slow down or stop time, when would you do so?
2. How much does the certainty of your own future-death impact your day-to-day view of life? (Honest reflection time)
3. Do you agree with Jesus' statement in John 5:28–29 that you will resurrect someday? How does your answer shape the way you live?
4. Re-read John 5:24. What difference does it make that eternal life starts now in your life spiritually?
5. Jesus claims to be the Giver of Life. Where have you looked for life apart from Jesus? What did you discover? Don't give the "right" answer; give the "honest" one. ;-)
6. Why do you think Jesus taught about being the Giver of Life immediately after healing the man who had been crippled for 38 years?
7. When has Jesus met you in your pain and how has that shaped your life with Him today?
8. Jesus points to several witnesses to validate His claims. What evidence have you seen that strengthens your confidence in Him?
9. John 5:41–47 reveals two common idols: "approval of others" and "self-righteousness." Which is a greater temptation for you and what has helped you resist it?
10. Read John 21:25. Jesus worked during His earthly ministry and His Spirit still works today. Share a story of what Jesus has done in your life?
