1. How would you rate your singing voice:

2. Do you like to sing in church? Why or why not? What do you think that “says” about you?

3. Most people make God's will about themselves! In other words, they want to know what is best for THEM—what school to attend, what job to take, and whom to marry. Why is this the wrong focus and a misunderstanding of the will of God?

After discussing the above, read these verses about God's will and comment on what is being said:

1 Thess. 4:3; 5:18; 1 Pet. 2:15; 3:17; Micah 6:8; Eph. 5:15–20; Col. 1:9

4. Do you want God's will for your life? I mean, really. Are you willing to do what HE wants for your life rather than what YOU want for your life? Discuss how hard it is to really submit one's will to God's will. What is the key? (Note: Phil. 2:13 offers some insight.)

5. What are you thankful for? Why?

6. In what areas of your life should you be more thankful? How can you increase your thankfulness in these areas?
