## Discussion Questions

4. Why do you think God sometimes answers our prayers with “no”? Consider reading 2 Corinthians 12:8-10.
5. Do people around you recognize that you have been transformed by God? Do you appear different from them?
6. Knowing that God is working, how is He calling you to join His mission?
7. This week, how could you commit to spending more time in pursuit of God?
8. Who is one person in your life that needs to know Jesus? Pray for that person and for an opportunity to share with them.
