





PRINCIPLE 1: Influence is not from Your Position; it is from Your Disposition

And he had a son whose name was Saul, a handsome young man. There was not a man among the people of Israel more handsome than he. From his shoulders upward he was taller than any of the people.







1 SAMUEL 9:21







1 SANUEL 31:8-10







1 SAMUEL 13:8-10


PRINCIPLE 1: Toxic People are Narcissistic

When you find yourself in a relationship with a person, where the relationship is completely one-sided and the other person is "always right" you are probably in a toxic relationship



PRINCIPLE 2: Toxic People Thrive on Drama







1 SANUEL 14:24-30

So none of the people had tasted food. 25 Now when all the people came to the forest, behold, there was honey on the ground. 26 And when the people entered the forest, behold, the honey was dropping, but no one put his hand to his mouth, for the people feared the oath.







1 SAMUEL 14:43-46

Far from it! As the LORD lives, there shall not one hair of his head fall to the ground, for he has worked with God this day." Toxic people enjoy complicating what would otherwise be simple situations because it keeps attention focused on







PRINCIPLE 3: Toxic People Play the Victim

1 SANUEL 13:11-12





Toxic people love to appear as martyrs and will even make up situations that portray them in that light.









PRINCIPLE 4: Toxic People Are Chronic Liars






PRINCIPLE 5: Toxic People are Unpredictable







