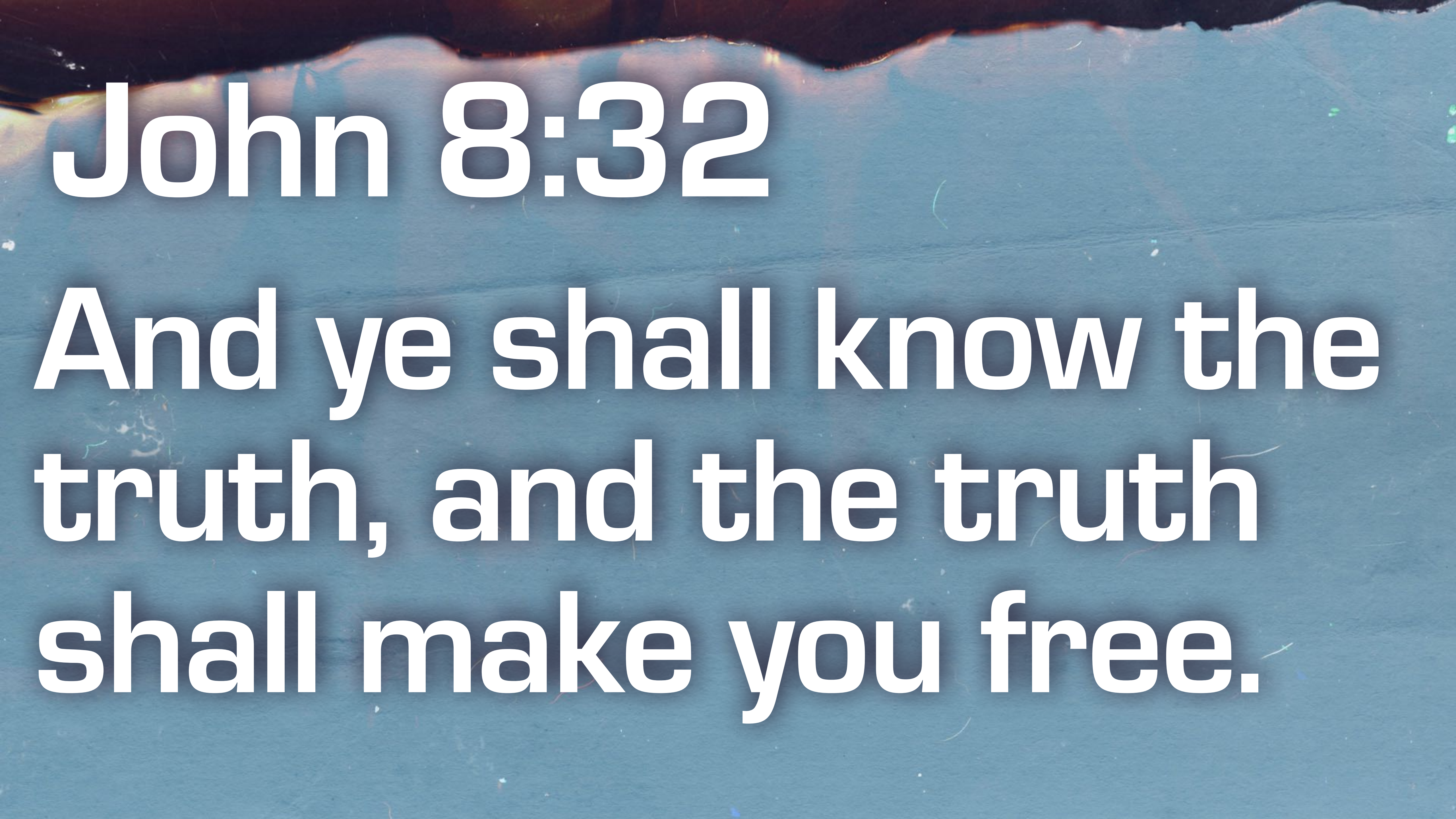


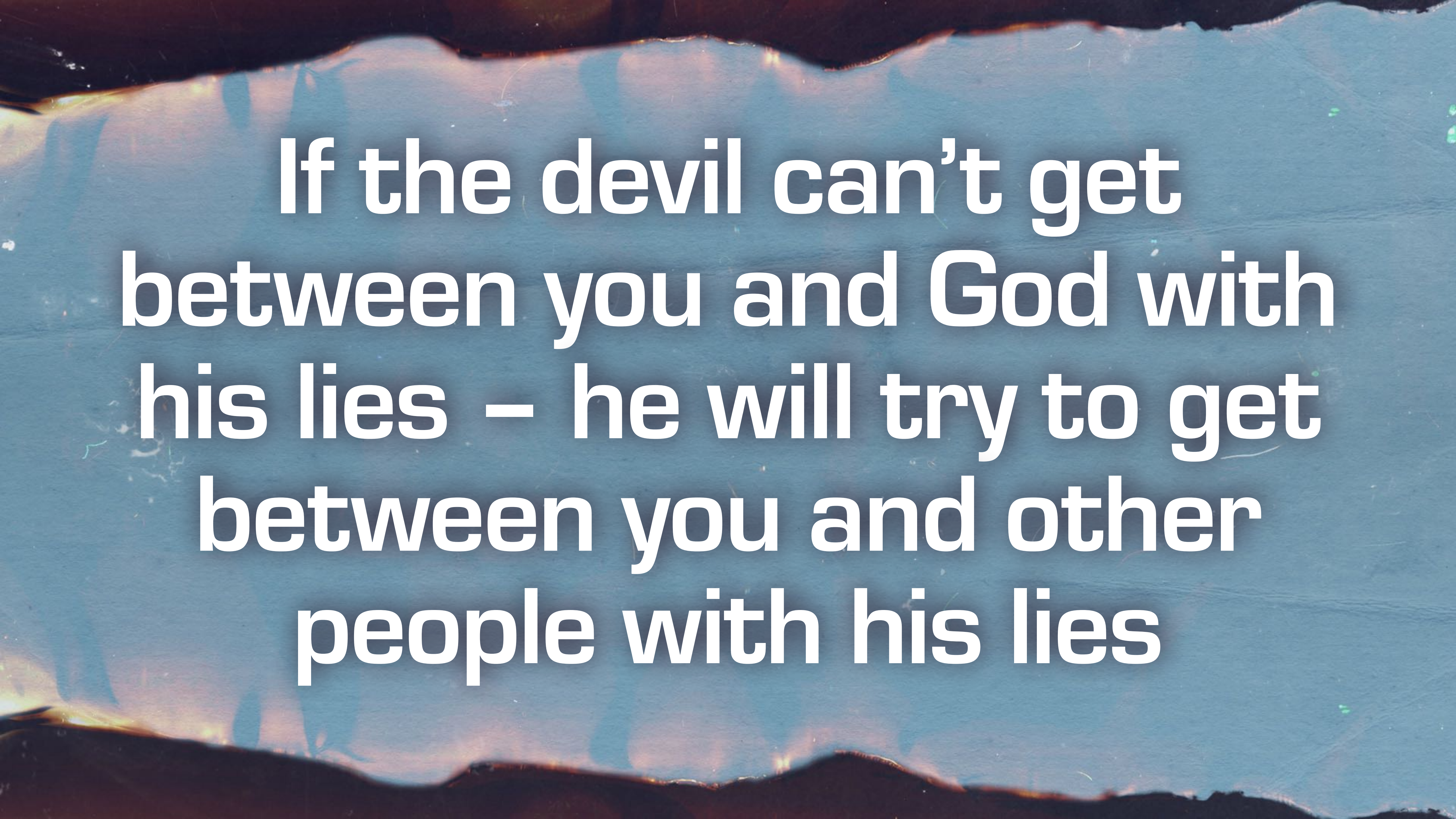
PANTS ON FIRE
