Principle 1:

Angels Show God's
Glory in Worship

Revelation 7:11

All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God

Isaiah 6:2

Above him stood the seraphim.
Each had six wings: with two he
covered his face, and with two
he covered his feet, and with
two he flew.

Isaiah 6:3

And one called to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!"

Principle 2:

Angels Give Direction

Judges 6:12

And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him, and said to him, "The LORD is with you, you mighty man of valor!"

Judges 6:15

And he said unto him, Oh my Lord,
wherewith shall I save Israel?
behold, my family [is] poor in
Manasseh, and I [am] the least in
my father's house

Judges 6:13

And Gideon said unto him, Oh my Lord, if the LORD be with us, why then is all this befallen us? and where [be] all his miracles which our fathers told us of, saying, Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt? but now the LORD hath forsaken us, and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites.



Principle 3:

Angels Protect You

Acts 27:22-24

Yet now I urge you to take heart, for there will be no loss of life among you, but only of the ship. For this very night there stood before me an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I worship, and he said, 'Do not be afraid, Paul; you must stand before Caesar. And behold, God has granted you all those who sail with you.'

Daniel 6:22

My God sent his angel and shut the lions' mouths, and they have not harmed me, because I was found blameless before him; and also before you, O king, I have done no harm."

Principle 4:

Angels Give Information

Luke 1:13-15

But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John. And thou shalt have joy and gladness; and many shall rejoice at his birth. For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb

Proverbs 3:5-6

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths

Principle 5:

Angels Escort You to
Heaven When You Die

Luke 16:19-22

There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day: And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores, And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;

Principle 6:

What Do Angels Look
Like?

Mark 16:5

And entering into the sepulchre,
they saw a young man sitting on
the right side, clothed in a long
white garment; and they
were affrighted

Genesis 18:1-2

And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day; And he lift up his eyes and looked, and, lo, three men stood by him: and when he saw them, he ran to meet them.
