



ACTS 21:10-11




To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, lit is because Ithere isl no light in them.

THE PROPHET'S PLACE IN THE FIVE-FOLD MINISTRY OF THE CHURCH

- Apostle: Governs by establishing vision and foundation
- · Prophet: Guides by giving direction through revelation
- Evangelist: Gathers (draws people to Christ)
- · Pastor: Guards by shepherding and nurturing
- Teacher: Grounds by rooting believers in sound doctrine

And he gave some, apostles, and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;



ACTS 20:28-29




