*Luke 1:28*

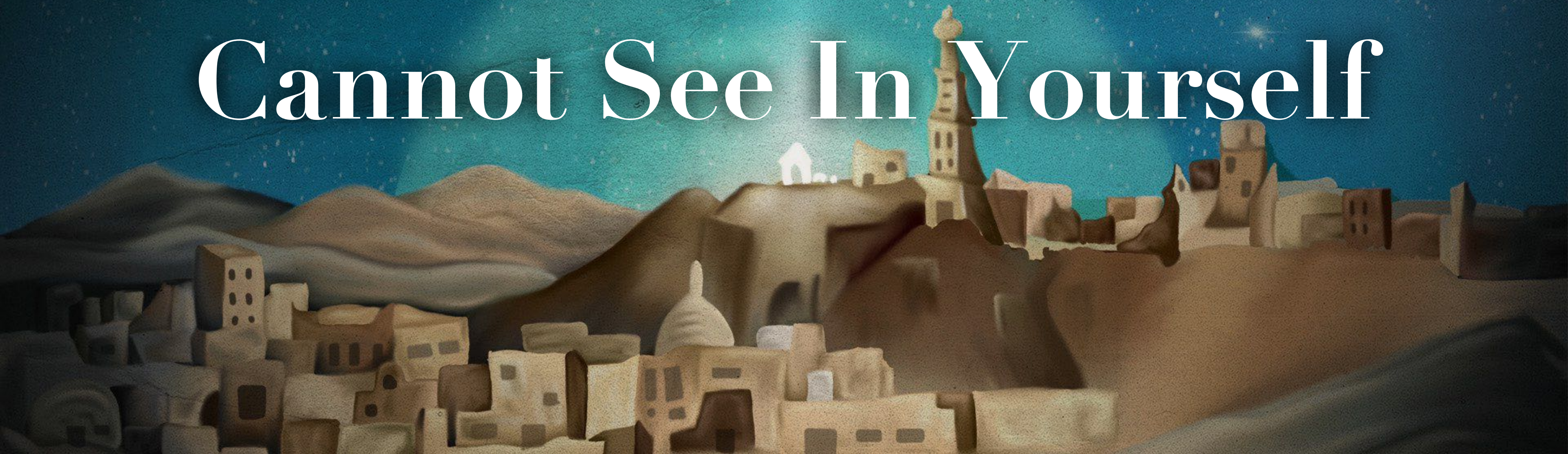
And the angel came in unto

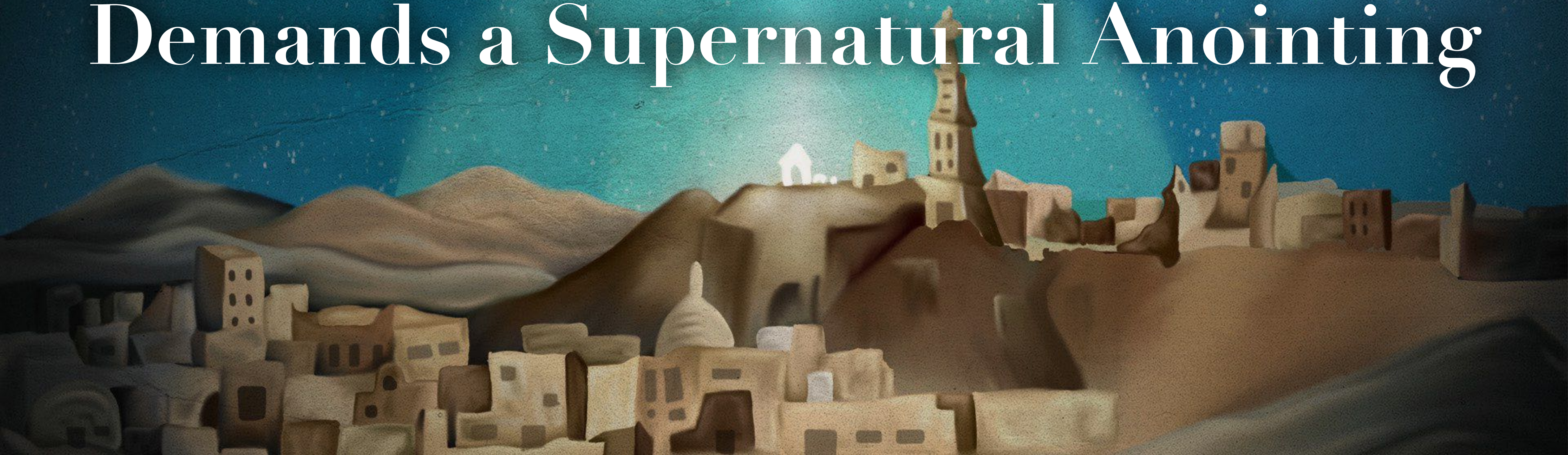
For with God nothing
