1 Corinthians 15:26


The last enemy [that] shall

Principle #1:

1 Corinthians 15:43

countenance was altered, and his
raiment [was] white [and] glistering



Principle #2:

**THE GLORIFIED BODY
WILL BE RECOGNIZABLE**

1 Corinthians 13:12

For now we see through a glass,
darkly; but then face to face: now I
know in part; but then shall I know
even as also I am known.

Luke 9:30, 33

And, behold, there talked with him two men, which were Moses and Elias: ... 33 And it came to pass, as they departed from him, Peter said unto Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias: not knowing what he said.

Principle #3:

**THE GLORIFIED BODY
WILL BE LIMITLESS**

John 20:19

Then the same day at evening, being the first [day] of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace [be] unto you.

Principle #4:

1 Corinthians 15:44-45

It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body. 45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam [was made] a quickening spirit.

1 John 1:1

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;
