Iuke 2:46-47

And it came to pass, that after three clays they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions. And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.

Luke 2:48

And when they saw him, they were amazed: and his mother said unto him, Son, why hast thou thus clealt with us? behold, thy father and I have sought thee sorrowing

And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?

Within the questions of Jesus we find the deeperanswers about life and our journey of faith. These questions demand that we probe within ourselves and God's Word to discover the answer to the question Jesus poses. These questions lead us to truly discover who we are and what God has for us

The wise always focus on the "whys"

2Timothy 2:15

Study to shew thy self approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be as hamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

Jesus never asked a "when" question

Luke 2255

And he said unto them, When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing? And they said, Nothing

In the eternal spectrum of eternity – the "when" loses relevance to the "why"

Mathew 6:27

Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?

Ouest on 1 What Are You Worried About?

Merely thinking about something does not change anything

Philippians 4:6

do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God,

Worry is taking your life out of God's hands and putting it into your own. That is the most selfish thing you could ever do

Refer5:7

Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you

Matthew 6:28-30

And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: 29 And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

Matthew 6:28-30

30 Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, [shall he] not much more [clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

Iuke 12:24
