CALLING: SHE PURSUES HER GOD-GIVEN GIFTS AND CALLINGS, KNOWING THAT HER HUSBAND'S LEADERSHIP SHOULD ENCOURAGE - NOT SUPPRESS -HER GROWTH IN THOSE GIFTS AND GALLINGS

RESPECT: SUBMISSION IS NOT THE SAME AS SILENT AGREEMENT; IT IS A RESPECTFUL ENGAGEMENT THAT BUILDS UNITY WITHIN THE RELATIONSHIP






