# It is much easier to judge the faults of someone else than it is to acknowledge our own



## Principle1: Being Critical Invokes the Law of Reciprocity



Mathew 7:1-2 Judge not, that you be not judged. 2 For with the judgment you pronounce you will be judged, and with the measure you use it will be measured to you

## Principle 2: Critical People are Insecure People



National 78 And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?



#### The habit of constantly pointing out the faults of other people is a manifestation of an insecurity about the very things that you judge other people for



#### The criticism you have of others is a mirror or reflection of how you feelabout yourself

## Principle3: Critical People Have a Problem with Forgiveness

COOSSIANS 3:13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so vou also must forgive.



## Principle 4: **Critical People Are Usually Hiding Their Own Shortcoming**



John 8-3-7The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery, and placing her in the midst 4 they said to him, "Teacher, this woman has been caught in the act of adultery. 5 Now in the Law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. So what do you say?" 6 This they said to test him, that they might have some charge to bring against him.
