





PRINCIPIE 1: Recognize Your Ream



PRINCIPLE 2: Pick Up Your Weapons Again


2 CORINTHIANS 10:4 For the weapons of our warfare [are] not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds

Your dominion and authority is in the supernatural realm and not the natural









PRINCIPIE 3: Allow God's Hand of Authority in Your Life Again






God can only work with those willing to work with Him
