Matthew 26:26 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed [it], and brake [it], and gave [it] to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

Exocus 12:5 Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take [it] out from the sheep, or from the goats:

Exodus 12:6 And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening

1 Speter 1:19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

1 Speter 2:22 Who did no sin, meither was guile found in his mouth

2 Gorinthians 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him

God dealt with Jesus, not as though He were a sinner, like other men, but as though He were sin itself, absolutely identified with it.



Galatians 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed [is] every one that hangeth on a tree:

BROMMINS 8:3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

Sohn 1:29The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world

1 Gorinthians 5:7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

Exodus 12:46 In one house shall it be eaten; thou shalt not earpy forth ought of the flesh abroad out of the house; neither shall ye break a bone thereof.

Psalm 34:20 He keepeth all his bomes: mot ome of them is broken.

John 19:32-33, 36 Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was erucified with him. 33 But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs: ... 36 For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken

The Lamb Provided Redemption Through the Blood

Exodus 12:13 And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.

Mattheuv 26:27-28 And he took the eup, and gave thanks, and gave [it] to them, saying, Drink ye all of it; 28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.



Ephesians 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;



1 Stohn 187 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

1 Speter 1818-19 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, [as] silver and gold, from your vain conversation [received] by tradition from your fathers; 19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:
