



EPHESIANS 3:1

THE DISPENSATION OF INNOCENCE

- •Time Period: Creation to the Fall of Man
- •Scripture Placement: Genesis 1-3
- •Responsibility: Man was to obey God and not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil
- •Failure: Adam and Eve disobeyed God.
- •Judgment: Man is expelled from the Garden of Eden and the curse enters the world

THE DISPENSATION OF CONSCIENCE

- •Time Period: From the Fall of Man to the Flood
- •Scripture Placement: Genesis 4-8
- •Responsibility: People were to live according to their conscience, which was informed by the knowledge of good and evil.
- •Failure: Widespread corruption and violence (Genesis 6:5).
- ·Judgment: The Great Flood.

THE DISPENSATION OF HUMAN GOVERNMENT

- •Time Period: Post-Flood to the Call of Abraham
- •Scripture Placement: Genesis 9-11
- •Responsibility: Humanity was to govern itself righteously under God's authority.
- •Failure: Pride and rebellion at the Tower of Babel.
- •Judgment: Confusion of languages and scattering of nations.

THE DISPENSATION OF PROMISE

- •Time Period: Call of Abraham to the Giving of the Law
- •Scripture Placement: Genesis 12 Exodus 19
- •Responsibility: Live by faith in God's promises, particularly the promise of land, seed, and blessing through Abraham.
- •Failure: The Israelites grew in number but eventually fell into slavery and unbelief
- ·Judgment: Bondage in Egypt.

THE DISPENSATION OF LAW


- •Time Period: Moses to the Cross
- •Scripture Placement: Exodus 20 Malachi (and into the Gospels before the crucifixion)
- ·Responsibility: Obey the Mosaic Law fully.
- •Failure: Israel repeatedly broke the covenant.
- •Judgment: Exile, oppression, and eventually the rejection of Christ.

THE DISPENSATION OF GRACE (THE CHURCH AGE)


- •The Dispensation of Grace (The Church Age)
- •Time Period: Pentecost to the Rapture (Acts 2 present)
- •Scripture Placement: Acts Revelation 3
- •Responsibility: Receive salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ; live by the Spirit.
- •Failure: Apostasy and widespread rejection of the gospel.
- •Judgment: The coming Tribulation period (Revelation 6–19).

THE MILLENNIAL REIGN OF CHRIST

- •Time Period: Second Coming of Christ to the End of the Millennium (1,000 years)
- •Scripture Placement: Revelation 20
- •Responsibility: Obey Christ as King during His literal reign on earth.
- •Failure: After 1,000 years, Satan is released and leads one final rebellion.
- •Judgment: Final defeat of Satan; Great White Throne judgment.




WEARE THE CONDUIT OF GOD'S GRACE - NOT THE CONTROLLER OF GOD'S GRACE








ACTS 9:3-6 as he journeyed he came








ACTS 2:17-18








UCHN 15:15

1CORINTHIANS 2:9-14

But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. 10 But God hath revealed Itheml unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. 11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God;

1CORINTHIANS 2:9-14

that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. 13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know [them], because they are spiritually discerned. We must depend on Him to open our eyes and hearts.
